Surface Preparation

Unpainted or weathered cement roof tiles:

- Clean thoroughly with a high-pressure water jet or by scrubbing with a hard-bristle or wire brush and water.
- Ensure the roof is completely dry before proceeding.
- If the tiles are still powdery or friable after cleaning, apply a *Bonding Liquid* (e.g., Plascon CVI 14). Allow to dry for at least 16 hours before painting.

Previously painted roof tiles:

- Inspect and remove all flaking or loose paint using a scraper or wire brush.
- Clean entire surface with *Sugar Soap* solution (e.g., 500g in 5L water).
- Rinse with clean water and allow to dry.
- If areas are bare or show signs of friability, treat with *Bonding Liquid* (e.g., CVI 14) and allow to dry before painting.

Application

- Stir Roof Paint (e.g., Plascon Nuroof Cool) thoroughly before use.
- Apply by brush, roller, or airless spray.
- Apply 2 full coats, allowing at least 2 hours drying time between coats.
- Do not dilute the paint.

Additional Notes

- Avoid painting when the temperature is below 10°C or in wet weather conditions.
- Start at the apex of the roof and work down, completing one sheet or tile section at a time to avoid lap marks.
- Ensure good ventilation and safety measures while working on roofs.
